Data Privacy Statement

We are committed to protecting your personal information and respecting your privacy. This Data Privacy Statement explains how MURBS (Maseno University Retirement Benefits Scheme) collects, uses, discloses, and safeguards your personal data in compliance with the **Data Protection Act, 2019** and other relevant laws.

1. Information We Collect

We collect the following types of personal information:

3. Legal Basis for Processing

We process your data based on the following legal grounds:

- Contractual Necessity: Data is processed to fulfill our obligations under the Scheme's rules or contracts with members.
- ii. Legal Obligations: Compliance with statutory requirements such as tax reporting and audits.
- **iii. Consent**: In cases where your explicit consent is required, such as for marketing or processing sensitive data.
- iv. Legitimate Interests: Where it is in our legitimate interest to improve services or protect Scheme assets, provided this does not override your rights and freedoms.

4. Data Sharing and Disclosure

We do not sell or rent your personal data. We may share your information in the following cases:

- i. Service Providers: With third-party vendors who assist in Scheme administration, IT support, or data storage, provided they adhere to strict confidentiality and data protection standards.
- ii. Legal Compliance: When required to comply with laws or government regulations.
- iii. International Transfers: If your personal data is transferred outside Kenya (e.g., for cloud storage), we will ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place, such as adherence to approved international data protection frameworks.
